## Holy Communion 1

What is Holy Communion, or the Sacrament of the Altar? Luther says in the Large Catechism: It is the true body and blood of the Lord Christ in and under the bread and wine which we Christians are commanded by Christ's word to eat and to drink (**LC**, **V**, **8**). How can this be? It is what we call a sacrament. The word sacrament means "mystery." It doesn't make sense, but when God's Word is added to the elements (bread and wine), it makes it a Sacrament, the body and blood of Jesus Christ in, with, and under the bread and wine.
